

Terms and Conditions:

This is a Classic Vehicle Show entitled “Motor Vehicles from the Last Century”

Vehicles must be at least 25 years old (vehicles registered up to 31 December 2001 are acceptable).

To book a vehicle into the show:

Please complete the entry form provided with this invitation (one entry form per vehicle please).

Entry forms can be forwarded, or copied, if required.

Please return completed entry forms via one of these methods:

- 1) Scan the form and attached it to an email. Send to: dave308gt4@outlook.com (preferred reply method).
- 2) Post it to the address shown on the top of the entry form (allow plenty of postage time!).
- 3) Hand deliver it to the address shown on the entry form.

New for 2026: due to the size of the field, only the first 110 entries received will be accepted. (Motorbike entries unlimited).

Please write your latest email address clearly on the entry form (even if posting or hand delivering it) as this provides us with somewhere to reply with confirmation of booking, plus, somewhere to email next year's invitation.

If you are posting your entry form because you do not have an email address, please include a Stamped Addressed Envelope (SAE) if you wish to receive next year's invite. Confirmation for posted bookings will be given via phone or text.

If you wish to remain on the invitation list for next year, and your contact information changes, please send us an update for our records (at any time), either via email (stating your new email address), via post or hand delivered note (with a revised SAE).

On the day:

The event begins at 11am and ends at 4:30pm.

Show vehicles are requested to arrive **no earlier than 9am – and no later than 11am** please.

Show vehicles are requested to stay until at least 3:30pm if possible (to eliminate vehicle movement during the peak period).

Any vehicle unexpectedly needing to leave early, must notify the nearest marshal before driving (for assistance out of the field).

Please carefully follow all instructions from marshals and kindly respect the job they have volunteered to do.

We may ask you to reverse-park, keeping parallel and slightly closer together than other shows (allowing space to open doors).

Reserving spaces for others is not allowed (please arrive together, if you wish to park together, informing the marshals on arrival).

Late arrivals:

The following applies to booked-in show vehicles that arrive after 11am:-

A judgement will be made by the organisers whether there is sufficient space on the field to allow late arrivals to join the event.

Entry will be entirely at the discretion of the marshals (if there is room, you will be directed to an available space).

If the show field is completely full, late arriving vehicles will be invited to temporarily park in the nearby Visitor's parking area.

In this case, please walk back to the show and (after a while) speak to a marshal. If room has become available, you will be able to return with your vehicle (where you will be directed to the available space).

Pease note: there must be no queuing, waiting, or parking in the road directly outside the show field, at any time.

Other Information:

Visitors:

Visitor's parking is available nearby. From the north, drive past the show field on the RHS, turn 1st left into Sawyer's Road. From the south, turn right into Sawyer's Road before you reach the show field. Look for the "car park" signs to direct you there.

It is just a short walk back to the show field from the visitor's car park.

Always take care with passing traffic.

Pease note: there must be no parking in the road directly outside the show field, at any time.

Toilets are available to use inside the Evangelical Church (*please keep them tidy at all times*).

Disabled parking is available on the gravel drive outside the Evangelical Church (*not in the show field please*).

Dogs are allowed, preferably on a lead (*please clear any mess in the normal way*).

Kindly take all forms of litter home with you before you leave. Thank you.

Charges and donations:

There is no admission charge for exhibitors and visitors. Woohoo! Long may that continue!

A huge amount of organisational effort, help and support, is given to the show by the All-Saint's Church in Little Totham. (*without this help, the event would be impossible to run*).

Donations to All-Saint's Church are always welcome, and will be gratefully received (*look for the blue collection bucket doing the rounds, or, found sitting on one of the tables*).

Please use the bar & catering facilities, plus the side-stalls (*items donated and sold in these facilities raises money for next year*).

Please bring £ cash for all purchases (*sorry, there are no card payment facilities on the show field*).

To the generosity of the Evangelical Church for lending tables and chairs and allowing use of their toilet facilities. Thank you.

To the owners of the private dwellings adjacent to either side of the field, and to the nearby houses that move their cars away from the gravel parking area outside the Evangelical Church. Thank you.
